Academic Integrity

Attendance

Students are expected to attend at least 80% of timetabled sessions per module. Absences affecting assessment eligibility should be reported to the department office with supporting evidence.

Campus Facilities

The Hay Al-Andalus campus includes software, networking and cyber security laboratories, a library and reading hall, a student lounge, and multi-purpose lecture halls. Facility hours are posted at each building entrance and on the Student Portal.
